- ★ *Key to life?* Is a cutting-edge mobile experience sharing the story of Jesus through unique, interactive and immersive experience using sight, sound, scent and touch. It is housed in a purpose built vehicle that transforms into a large, interactive learning space.

Using floor to ceiling touch screens children can explore what Christians believe and understand how the story of Jesus is the Key to Christianity. Designed by educationalists to work alongside school's existing RE teaching.

- ★ *The Life Exhibition* is an exciting, multi-media experience about the life of Jesus aimed at primary school pupils. Using interactive tablets, colourful graphic panels, films and songs. The Life Exhibition helps Key stage 2 pupils learn about Jesus – his birth, teachings, miracles, death and resurrection.

A church or group of churches will hire the exhibition usually for a week, then after some training, will invite primary schools in their area to visit. The exhibition complements existing teaching in schools.
